"We carry Yonka which is French, Ilike which is Hungarian and Phytobiodermie which is Swiss. Yonka is our top-selling European skin care line and for our clients who will only consider 100-percent organic, Ilike is the product of choice. Phytobiodermie has an eye cream containing karite shea nut butter and rosemary for microcirculation for the delicate eye area," Mansori said. "The most advanced trends in the industry are working with stem cells. We have recently discovered a local company (BioRegenerative Sciences), whose products restore human growth factor and the results are profound. It's made with a lot of integrity and super clean."

Most professional spa, salon and retail products commonly available contain a hidden ingredient, which is alcohol or a mix of alcohol and water. This is a common solvent used for herbal extraction (liquid solution) and its main purpose is shelf life and convenience.

Organic products like Ilike — which meets strictly enforced organic standards and is recognized internationally — contain



whole fruit and herb pulps as primary active ingredients, and are created with raw materials and with no synthetics. They are ecological and socially compatible, including Fair Trade but excluding genetic engineering and animal cruelty.

Transport yourself into a Renaissance "living" painting at The Spa at the Grand Del Mar resort by soaking in the hot mineral waters set in a Mediterranean palazzo. It claims the distinction of being awarded the Forbes Five Star. The spa's organic product offered is PreVious, under the auspices of Beauty by Clinica, which was originally created for the Burn and Reconstructive Surgery Unit in Rio de Janeiro, Brazil by Dr. Ivo Pitanguy.

It touts four innovative peptides claiming collagen production, cell multiplication, wrinkle reduction and free-radical elimination. And as if this cup of youth didn't already run over, key essential ingredients of Vitamin E for antioxidants, organic selicium for cell renewal and botanical extracts (geranium, sandalwood, neroli) are added for aromatherapy.

"I enjoy using Clinica Beauty because I find it healing for all skin types, all ages — for both men and women," said Jen Woog, the spa's lead esthetician. "The line's main ingredient, centella asiatica, is a rainforest super plant that contains rare cell regenerative properties, which help to repair skin damage and prevent future damage."
